If you are a UK taxpayer you can use Gift Aid to make your donations to firstsite go further by simply completing this form.

Are you a higher rate UK taxpayer?

If you pay the higher rate of tax, you can claim further tax relief via your self assessment tax return. Based on your donation, you can claim the difference between the basic rate and the higher rate tax. For more details visit www.hmrc.gov.uk

To qualify for gift aid, you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year (currently 25p for every £1 given).* Tax year is 6 April one year to 5 April the next.

Please note:

- You can cancel this declaration by notifying firstsite at any time
- If your circumstances change and you no longer pay enough income or capital gains tax to cover the amount claimed by the charity, you can cancel your declaration
- You need to inform firstsite of any changes to your name or address

*Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25 pence on the pound
